→ Nov 2012 – Jan 2014: Lead developer on Digital Reader apps, primarily for iPads and iPhones. These Xamarin apps enable customers to read digital versions of Bauer's printed magazines. The project encompasses 30+ Apple Newsstand apps, a standard Apple Appstore 'Kiosk' app with 70+ magazines and an Android Java app for Samsung tablets.

In Jan 2014, Apple selected one of our titles, *Rolling Stone Magazine*, in its 'Best of 2013' selection for iTunes Australia. Appendix A at the end of the CV shows how the Apple Newsstand homepage appeared in iTunes in Jan 2013 with each of my project's apps highlighted.

→ 2009 – Nov 2012: Senior and the Lead developer on a team which serviced retail / newsagents. Projects included: managing high volume websites, WinForms desktop apps for warehouse operations, a Windows Mobile based barcode scanning app and a Silverlight mapping solution to plot the location of newsagents

Vero is part of Suncorp, one of Australia's largest insurers. My two main contract roles at Vero were:
→ Senior dev on a .Net 3.5 ASP.Net web project for insurance brokers. I was first dev on the team which grew to 20 devs. Core technology used included Nhibernate, DB2 dbs, and multiple web & app servers
→ Development Manager, liaising with other teams within the organisation to get server environments (including F5 load balancers) set-up, managing deployments to those environments and managing the environments during System Testing, UAT and Production dev cycles

→ Part of a two member team writing SMS apps. We liaised directly with mobile operators, such as Vodafone, and acted as an SMS gateway for our client's communication with the operators. Example apps included Office add ons to send SMS messages from Outlook, radio station text-in apps which showed messages to DJs and Premium SMS receiver apps.
