I was hired out of college into Wireless In Motion which was a startup company with between 2 and 5 employees.

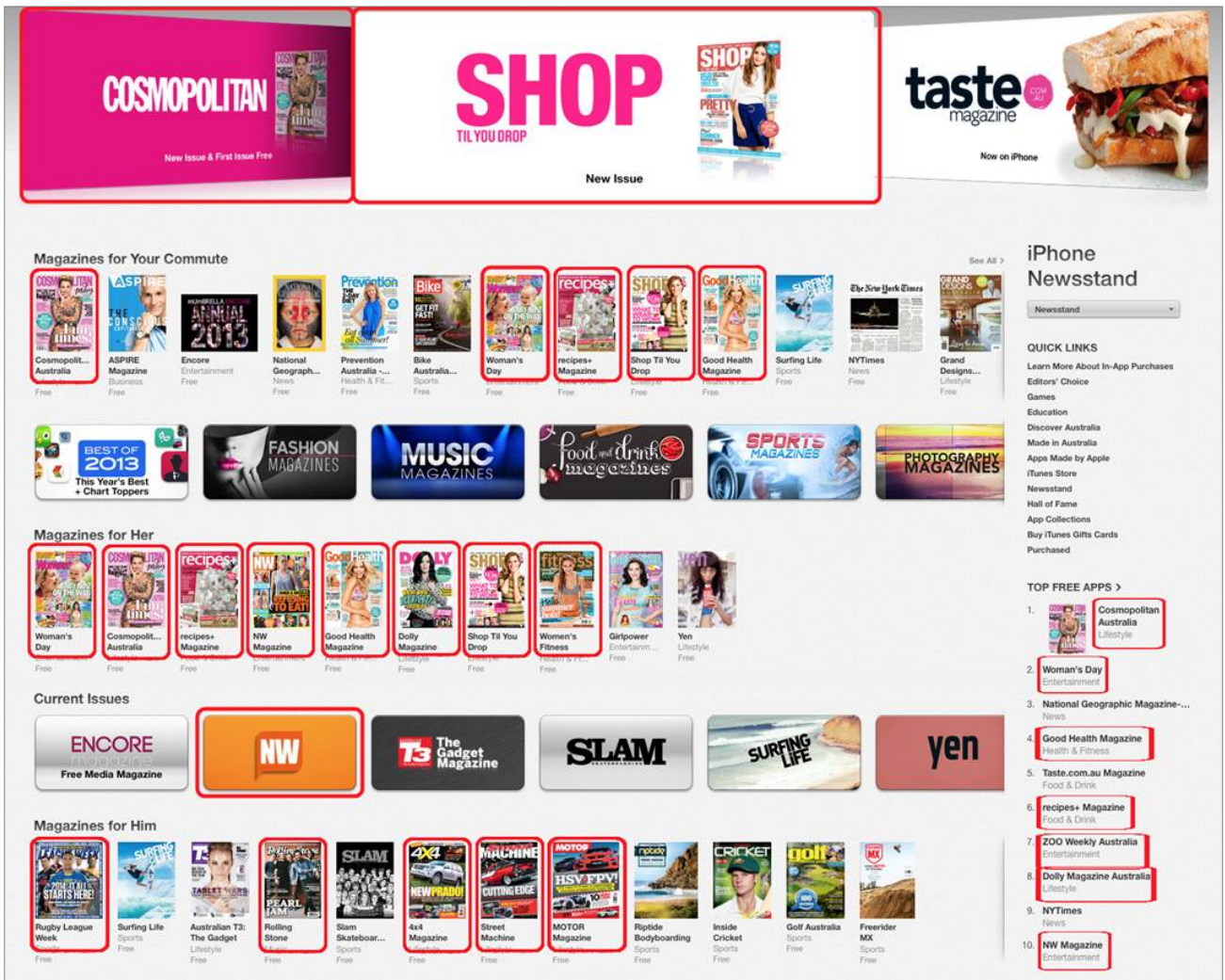
→ Core dev on various mobile apps for commercial and industrial clients. The apps were typically for Windows Phone and were written in C#

Example apps included Office adds on to send SMS messages from Outlook, radio station text-in apps which showed messages to DJs and Premium SMS receiver apps aimed at Businesses.
